


## Demographics Average Grade in High School


### Hours spent during typical week studying/homework while in high school

"High" represents students who scored one-half standard deviation or more above the mean (i.e., higher than 55).












### CIRP Theme Interaction with Teachers Frequency of Activity During the Past Year as High School Senior





### CIRP Theme Active and Collaborative Learning Frequency of Activity During the Past Year as High School Senior








### CIRP Theme Academic Disengagement Frequency of Activity During the Past Year as High School Senior



Social Agency measures the extent to which students' value political and social involvement as a personal goal.








Social Self-Concept is a unified measure of students' beliefs about their abilities and confidence in social situations.

Likelihood of College Involvement is a unified measure of students' expectations about their involvement in college life generally.


High Likelihood of College Involvement








### To how many colleges other than this one did you apply for admission this year?







In deciding to go to college, how important to you was each of the following reasons?


